

## **Camp Olympia Parent/Guardian Agreement and Notice of Policies**

I represent that I am a custodial parent or legal guardian of the child I am enrolling and that the child I am Enrolling is healthy and fully able to participate in all camp activities. I agree to provide Camp Olympia With a properly completed medical form, based on an exam performed less than one year of my child's last day at camp, as required by the City of New York and the Board of Health prior to my child attending camp. I hereby grant permission to Camp Olympia to take my child on all scheduled trips and outing and to photograph or record on video tape all camp activities and to use any photograph or video in which my child appears in for promotional literature, displays or any other formant representing Camp Olympia to the community including the Camp Olympia website. I release all rights to such. I do hereby give permission to Camp Olympia to obtain the necessary emergency medial treatment for my child, with the understanding that the family is notified as soon as possible.

### **Payment Policy**

I agree and understand that a \$100 deposit is required to ensure his or her space. The \$100 is non-refundable after May 31. The \$100 deposit will be deducted from the cost of my camp session. If I choose not to leave the non-refundable \$100 deposit per child I understand that I may be locked out of a session. I understand and agree that all payments will be made in full on or prior to June 11, 2010. If my payment is made after the due date I understand there will be a \$20 late fee charge in addition the camp balance

### **Refund Policy**

I understand that no refunds or adjustments will be made for incidental absences including, but not limited to, illness or failure to provide a medical form.

### **Camp Bounced Check and Fee Policy**

I understand and agree that Camp Olympia will charge me a \$25 surcharge for any bounced check they receive from me for camp and that Camp Olympia reserves the right not to accept additional checks from me and will only accept cash or money orders for future camp payments.

### **T-shirt and Water Bottle Policy**

Each day I will provide my child with his/her t-shirt and water bottle and I understand and agree that if Camp Olympia has to provide my child with a camp t-shirt or water bottle I agree to be charged and pay Camp Olympia (\$12 for such t-shirt and \$1 for water bottle).

### **Sneaker Policy**

Children must wear sneakers (with enclosed toe and fastened with laces or Velcro) every day in order to participate in camp activities. No sandals, flip flops, opened toed shoes, loafers...

### **Other Policies**

Camp Olympia reserves the right to ask your child to leave camp if it is determined that he/she is a danger to themselves or others. Camp Olympia asks that the parent/guardian disclose all pertinent information regarding their child's past school experiences and/or behavior so we may help you decide if our camp is appropriate for your child.

Camp Olympia recommends that you label all personal items with your child's name. Camp Olympia is not responsible for any lost, stolen or misplaced items.

### **Upon Entrance to Camp**

I agree that my child cannot enter camp until this form, application and medical have been signed and dated and returned to the administrative office with the required payment for entrance to camp. I have read and understand the above information and agree to its terms.
